KIM PHUC – In 1972, Kim Phuc's photo, a nine-year-old girl running from her burning Vietnamese village, was front-page news around the world. Since that time, Kim has forgiven those responsible for the napalm bombings and leads the Kim Phuc Foundation, an outreach to children scarred by war. Also serves as UNESCO spokesperson.



DONALD W. SHRIVER – Internationally renowned theologian, ethicist, author, and President Emeritus of Union Theological Seminary. His most noteworthy book is An Ethic for Enemies: Forgiveness in Politics



BRYAN STEVENSON, JD – Nationally recognized for his innovation in advancing the cause of justice in the United States. Co-recipient of the Gruber Foundation Justice Prize and winner of the MacArthur Foundation Wisdom Award. Founder and Executive Director of the Equal Justice Initiative and a professor at NYU School of Law.
